Summary

As we mature, we are more responsible to receive redemption and reconciliation more freely so we can obtain perfection. The problem is not that He doesn't freely give; it's that we find it difficult to receive. We must give up responsibility of manufacturing things on our own because it's not about our skill and great faith. We are pursuing God from a natural way and linear perspective expecting things to occur in a sequence of events, but God works in various dimensions, not time. The Kingdom of God is a dimension of impossibilities and a way of doing things that does not line up with our natural perspective. Our thoughts and ways are not possible in God's dimension, but in being led by the Spirit we have the ability to access deeper dimensions in God and call things into existence now.

A. Freely Receive

- a. The death, burial and resurrection was both done in the flesh and spirit, natural and spiritual.
- b. In our messed up lives, we didn't have to do anything good for Jesus to die for us.
- c. We've got nothing to prove. It's not about skill, great faith and perfection. He freely gives, but we find it difficult to receive. (Romans 8:32)
- d. Receive redemption; receive reconciliation so you can obtain perfection.
- e. As we mature, we are more responsible to receive it even more freely.
- f. Our faith in God grows because we are more dependent on God.
- g. Give up the fight and responsibility of manufacturing.
- h. If I freely received my salvation, how much more now should I freely receive all things. Not because my faith has increased, but the increase of my faith is a result of Him freely giving. (Ephesians 2:8, Romans 4:16)
- i. Our faith must never be that we trust in ourselves, but trust in God.
- j. True freedom is the ability to receive. (Matthew 10:8)
- k. As we move onto maturity and perfection never take responsibility of being God. Once you think you are God then you think you need to manufacture. We've got nothing to manufacture. You are only to receive. (Genesis 1:26)
- I. It's only in the freedom of receiving can you truly give.
- m. God gave Jesus the ministry of reconciliation, but you can never do that effectively if you think your reconciliation ministry is about your great maturity. (2 Corinthians 5:18)
- n. Nothing easier in life than to be saved. Why do we feel now we have to work so hard?

B. Realm of Impossibilities/Dimensions in God

- a. Romans 6:4-11
- b. We are very natural in our thinking since the day we were born.
- c. God's ways are not scientific. His ways are not designed to make natural sense. (Isaiah 55:8-9, Philippians 2:5)
- d. Carnal still a mere man, natural, perceiving things in a parallel dimension. God works in a different dimension. (1 Corinthians 3:2)
- e. God started with a finished job and a finished mentality. (Isaiah 46:10)
- f. Death, burial, resurrection, ascension and return of Christ we formulate a concept of how God works and does things based on a linear perspective.
- g. We are waiting for a trumpet to sound in a linear perspective of time. In a way He has returned already. We are waiting to be healed of God when we have been healed already. (1 Corinthians 15:52)
- h. We are pursuing God from a natural way and perspective. We get disappointed, because we're not seeing things that we should.
- i. God doesn't work in scientific blocks of time. Time is a created thing.
- j. We are waiting for a sequential set of events to take place for us to receive and achieve the things God has for us. God doesn't work that way.
- k. The Kingdom of God is a dimension and a way of doing things. (Matthew 6:33) It's seeking His way of doing things (Kingdom of God) and Him being right (righteousness), lose your way of doing things and the concept of you being right from a scientific perspective.
- I. If you bring skill into the Kingdom of God, you will never achieve what God wants you to achieve.
- m. Kingdom of God dimension of impossibility. Our natural thoughts and ways are not possible in God's dimension.
- n. God's philosophy is not 1+1=2, 1+1=10. (Deuteronomy 32:30)
- o. When Jesus died, we died and were buried together with Him. The resurrected life is the Zoe life of God, now. Why are you waiting to get that life again when He comes?
- p. It's an overlapping of dimensions in God, and we've got to be led by the Holy Spirit so we can be led in these different dimensions in God.
- q. You have access to every dimension that will ever exist. In God, they are done. It's up to you to connect.
- r. If you want to connect to the dimension that you're not going to die again, connect to that level. If you want to connect that you will die again, than connect to that. Lazarus died twice. Elijah never died.
- s. Science always pushes to 'one day'. (Mary & Martha, John 11:24) Jesus says, "It is now".
- t. God is in you, and you are in Him and you are one with Him. It's you that needs to connect to that dimension of God.
- u. Be in control of the time dimension, you're not a slave of time. You can access that which is to come, now. Why? You make it now. (Psalm 8:6)
- v. Zoe life has to be accessed and experienced now so you can do the work of the ministry.
- w. He's not a God who scientifically calculates things into being.
- x. Be like God, start calling things into existence. (Romans 4:17)
- y. Death is the last enemy. He is coming back when that enemy is under your feet. (1 Corinthians 15:26)
- z. This is the life that gives you that prosperity that God has promised.
- aa. Enoch (Genesis 5:24) and Elisha (2 Kings 2:11-12) crossed over into another dimension.

- bb. You have an ability to get into a deeper dimension with Him everything is at your disposal, you access it.
- cc. When God gives us the greatest of things, we get more religious to resist it. Most of us pull the scriptures out when we resist something.
- dd. Science is there to disprove. Don't wait for science, but lead science and do it first.
