Kingdom of God – Part 21

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Summary

We do not *need* money. When we need money, it becomes our master. We *require* money. Money needs us to fulfill its purpose. It is a tool, which can be used for good or evil. Just as a carpenter is in control of his hammer, so we too are to be in control of the tool God has given us, money. Money can hear and speak. It has a voice and ears. We must speak to money and command it to fulfill the purpose that it was designed for. Money is already in our spiritual account, we are to speak to it and command it to manifest into our lives. It is the blessing of the Lord that makes you rich, not money.

A. Money is Either Speaking or Obeying

- a. Money has ears and a mouth. If money is a servant, it has ears to hear. If it's a master, it has to speak and has a mouth. (Matthew 6:24)
- b. The original design and purpose for money coming into your life, was never by you toiling. It was designed to come into your life by you speaking to it.
- c. World says supposed to work hard for money.
- d. You don't need money, money needs you. I require money. Money is looking for me.
- e. Command money, speak to it, it's your servant.
- f. Creation has spiritual speech. Revelation is spiritual speech and spiritual perception.
- g. Money speaks. (James 5:1-4) If the righteous don't have a manifestation/if money hasn't yet shifted into your hands, it cries out to God. Money hears your voice, God hears money's voice, God hears your voice, and all interacts so that it abounds to your account.

B. Money Has Spiritual Purpose and Design

- a. In your hands, money fulfills its purpose. Unrighteous people's hands – use money for unrighteous purpose.
- b. Money is neither good nor evil, but takes on the character in whose hands it's found.
- c. You need to manifest who you are (Romans 4:17).
- d. You've already got the wrong perception of how money comes into your hand if you automatically think you must work.
- e. Speak like God – how He has a relationship with the material world.
- f. Why does money need you? To fulfill its purpose and design.
- g. Money is created by God – it has a spiritual purpose and design.

- h. If your concept of money is natural, you will attract it in the natural – achieved only by toil and hard work. (1 Corinthians 2:13)
 - i. Money is a spiritual thing. Covenant is a spiritual thing. (Deuteronomy 8:18)
 - j. Before you see money in your natural account, you've got to know that it's in your spiritual account. Spiritual account needs to be your reality.
 - k. Money is required to meet your needs. Shift from need to desire. (Psalm 37:4)
 - l. If your basic human needs are not met, there is not an overflow for you to give.
 - m. Anointing of God meets your needs. God meets needs of people through you and me.
 - n. You cannot give what you don't have. You can't engage humanity's needs if you are so needy yourself. (Luke 4:18)
 - o. Material world can be spoken to. All material origins find its beginnings in the spirit. (John 1:3) If it has its origin in the spirit, you can engage with it.
 - p. Intellectualism is confining and limiting. Godly wisdom has no limits; Godly wisdom is power and ability. (1 Corinthians 2:4)
 - q. You can't engage with the material world first in the natural, than you are a slave to it. The material world has its origins in the spirit. Engage in the spirit realm, it has no limits.
 - r. Everything we see comes out of the heart of God including money.

C. Money Needs You to Take Control of It

- a. Can you see health, salvation? Yes. We gain our health in the spirit (1 Peter 2:24), we engage in the spirit and it manifests. Why don't we do that with our money?
- b. Did you have to work for your salvation? Why do you have to work for your money?
- c. Not saying, don't work, but most of us work for it first.
- d. God can give you the greatest thing which is salvation, but He's powerless to give you your money that way?
- e. He's not going to still give you money; He's already given it to you. (Ephesians 1:3) In the spiritual realm, it's there. It's not manifest because you're engaging it in the natural and you don't have power over it. The power over it is first in the spirit.
- f. When you are engaged in the natural – working in the Kingdom of darkness.
- g. When money controls us, we don't know that we despise God. We don't even know we are doing it. We are doing it by darkness, lack of knowledge and revelation.
- h. Speak to money, call money forth – you confidently do that when you have a right relationship with it. (Romans 8:19)
 - i. How are you working out your money? Is it in the natural, or the spiritual? (Isaiah 55:8)
 - j. If Jesus was in your shoes, would He do it like you?
 - k. He wants us to be wise, skillful and intellectual – but is this where you start? This is a description whether you are living in the spirit or in the flesh.
 - l. Blessing of the Lord: is money the blessing? House? Car? No. It's the power and ability and anointing of God. The blessing makes you rich, money doesn't make you rich. Lots of money doesn't mean rich, it can equal poor. Blessing always equals rich. Blessing can never equal poor. (Proverbs 10:22, Revelation 3:17)
 - m. Money doesn't define you. The blessing of the Lord defines you.
 - n. Money is a tool – the greatest loving tool. The handyman is in control of the tool.
 - o. When money makes you rich, it's in control of you.
 - p. Are you rich with money? What defines it? Your bank account? The blessing of the Lord?
 - q. Engage God, through the power of faith and the anointing to manifest it out of the spirit into the natural.
 - r. No need for money in heaven. How come you have a need for it now? (Matthew 6:10)

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- s. You can own what's in heaven now. (Matthew 6:19-20, Luke 12:32)
- t. How do you engage what's in heaven? How do you store that treasure? By not depending on money on the earth, and depending on the blessing.
