Life from the Spirit

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Summary

God's purpose for your salvation is for you to live a life here on the earth like God, otherwise, salvation has no power. Creation isn't waiting for you to go to heaven; it's waiting for you to manifest who you are, not through the flesh, but through the spirit. The way to live with God is to live in the spirit by the Word; it's to live in a realm, a space and a time where all things are done. The flesh is carnality. Carnality is described when our response is not from the Word of God. The flesh is real, but the spirit is more real. What makes you spiritual is thinking in-line with the Word of God; it's believing God for a result even if it's not manifesting; it's when truth is your ultimate reality, not your experiences.

A. Reconciliation Unto God

- a. Reconciliation is an establishing of something that pre-existed. We cannot be reconciled back to God without the concept of union in our minds. (Romans 8:1-17)
- b. Salvation is a door. If salvation is everything, then you are going to live a life where everything can happen to you.
- c. God is a very purposeful being. (Ecclesiastes 3:1)
- d. God's purpose for your salvation is for you to live a life here on the earth like God, otherwise, salvation has no power.
- e. We started in a place of absolute union with God. When He released us, we were released into sin. Death came by sin, separated us and through salvation we could come back to our Life-Source. (Genesis 3:13, Deuteronomy 28)
- f. You've been justified by faith just as if you've never sinned. The work of the cross brought you into a state for you to live successfully. (1 Corinthians 1:30)

B. Manifesting Who You Are

- a. We have to live a different way, by a different set of rules that God's established.
- b. Present time reflects the time and the season we are in. You are not to be in a season forever, a manifestation must take place. (Romans 8:18)
- c. The creature is waiting for you to manifest, expose and reveal yourself. Creation has been created with the hope that the manifestation of God will be seen not only on humanity but on creation. (Romans 8:19)
- d. Creation (animals, plants, stones) aren't waiting for you to go to heaven, they're waiting for a process of manifesting who you are, not through the flesh, but through the spirit.

- e. Why would creation be expecting a manifestation of you? It too needs to be redeemed. (Romans 8:20-21)
- f. If something is being gathered up into Christ, it's being redeemed. (Ephesians 1:10)
- g. The spiritual way of knowing your needs are met is that God is gathering together with you all the provision that He's ever had for your life.
- h. The whole process of God changing our lives is not by us seeking an external switch, it is union with God, where you and God are one because you are reconciled with Him.
- i. The way to live with God is to live in the spirit by the Word; it's to live in a realm, a space and a time where all things are done.
- j. Ask yourself, where am I living at? In the flesh or the spirit?
- k. It's possible as a child of God to live in the flesh. The flesh is carnality; it's a way of thinking and living; it causes a default in responses. Anger, hatred, murder is the fruit of the flesh. (Romans 8:7, James 4:4)
- l. You've been designed to live from a spirit dimension and a spirit realm where things are happening and taking place from the Word of God.
- m. To walk after the flesh is to have a mind that is set in the way things are done contrary to the Word of God, which includes responding to feelings, circumstances and the way this world operates. (Romans 8:1)
- n. It is the power of God in a life that's been resurrected and reunified with God that has the capacity to be intellectual, but how you get what you're getting is the issue. (Deuteronomy 8:17-18)
- o. We are all designed to obtain things from God the same way.

C. Kingdom Ways

- a. What is the Kingdom of God? It is a realm of governance where God does things His way. It's a way of doing. It's a realm, a dominion, the way things operate; it's how He does what He does. (Matthew 6:33)
- b. Seeking the kingdom of God – we think heaven and salvation by default, not an order or a way of doing.
- c. A kingdom is not a democracy, it is a kingdom where the king has a way of doing things and everyone follows. It operates for the benefit of everybody.
- d. You have to work with a certain set of principals and way of doing things because we are ambassadors here on earth. (John 15:19)

D. Carnality and Spirituality

- a. Carnality is described when our response is not from the Word of God. It's when things are thought through and achieved in the same way as the world. (Matthew 6:7)
- b. What makes you spiritual is thinking in-line with the Word of God.
- c. The flesh is real, but the spirit is more real. (John 6:63)
- d. The body and mind are causing responses either by what the flesh is feeding it or by what the spirit is feeding it.
- e. The spirit can only feed the mind the Word of God, and the flesh can only feed the mind experiences. Your experiences shape the way you think.
- f. We've got to take the Word and replace our experiences with truth (the Word of God).
- g. What you experience is not truth; it's reality.
- h. There are two dimensions that we can be living in: the dimension of the Word of God where He is supreme and He reigns and is feeding you truth, or you live in a natural realm where you're being fed truth, but living by your senses.

- i. Faith-filled words are when you can acknowledge where you're at, but you know there's another way of living/achieving and you have a purpose to your words.

E. Achieving in God

- a. How do you class a fail? It's when you give up on what you're believing God for as a result of it not manifesting; it's you making up your mind about truth because natural experiences are defining what you believe. The failure is giving up hope, belief and faith. (Hebrews 11)
- b. The Word is living and it's alive. You came alive by the Word of God and are reconciled back to God to be just like Him. (Hebrews 4:12, Romans 4:17, Genesis 1)
- c. Having doesn't come before receiving. Your receiving comes before having. (Mark 11:24)
- d. If you pray what God doesn't want for you, He doesn't hear you and cannot give it to you. (1 John 5:14-15)
- e. Praying in the spirit is not just speaking in tongues; it's praying the Word of God.
- f. God doesn't always release things to us – it's based on His will, whether we're ready for it, if we're in the right place and if we have the right motives.
- g. If you want to achieve in God, don't give up, even if you have the wrong motives.
